Awards in this class do not qualify for any other WSSC events or points towards annual awards.
Walk to heel, sit & stay, recall, seen or simple unseen retrieve, hunting

Puppy: Between 6 and 18 months on the date of the assessment test
Walk to heel, sit & stay, recall, seen or simple unseen retrieve, hunting

Novice: Not been placed 1st in a minor breed spaniel novice working test or 1st twice in a minor breed spaniel novice assessment test
Not been placed 1st in an AV novice test
Not been placed 1st or 2nd in an open working test or assessment test
Not been placed in awards or awarded COM in a Field Trial
Not having been awarded a SGWC or KCWGC
Hunting, steadiness to shot, seen/unseen retrieve, possible water test

Open: Dogs will be required to work under normal shooting conditions

The Judges may alter the above tests at their sole discretion
